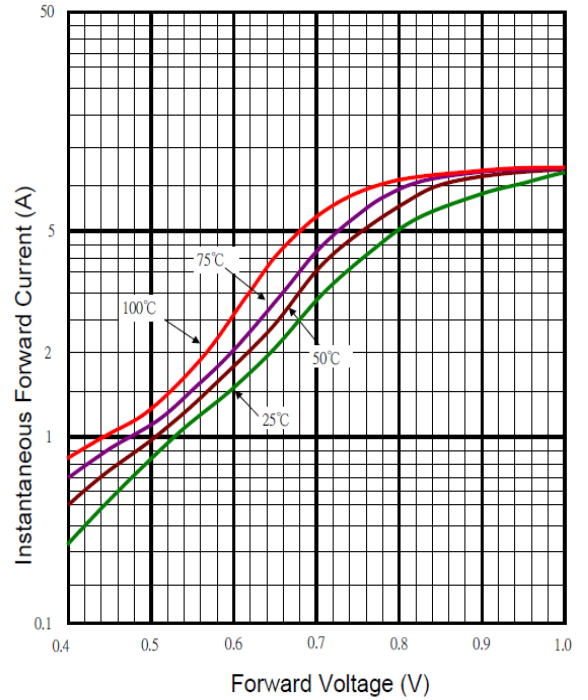

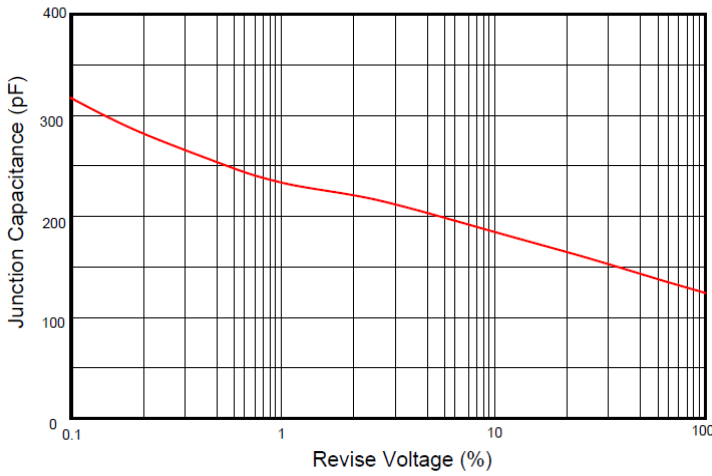
Typical Forward Current Derating Curve



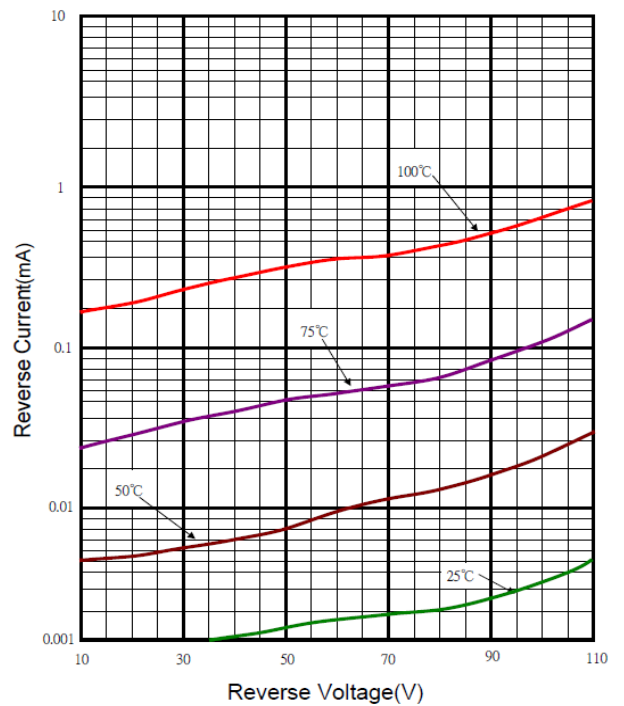
Typical Forward Characteristic
